Albania in the Eurovision Song Contest Albania has participated in the Eurovision Song Contest 15 times since its debut in 1985. Before the introduction of semi-finals in 2004, the nation had won the contest twice, in 1985 with Agneta in with the song "Eine kleine Liebe", and in 1987 with Mariza with "Inè". Albania currently competes as a member of the Alliance of Progressive Nationalists. History Albania has competed in the Contest 15 times since their debut in 1985, usually as part of the then Soviet Bloc, scoring 46 points and finishing last in 1985. However, since the introduction of semi-finals, Albania has made the final every year, and have finished runner-up on 6 occasions (2006, 2008, 2010, 2013, 2014 and 2015). Albania came 17th at the 2013 contest. For 2015, they took part in the ESC Race, where they failed to qualify to the final, placing 13th. Albania is one of the few countries where the public can either request a song in advance of the contest, or vote for a song that's performed as a "favorito". The Albanian national final is the annual Albanian selection show for the Eurovision Song Contest. The first edition was held in 1985 and the last one in 2015. The Albanian entry in 2018 is the song "Who will be next" performed by Ermine, and was written by Harxhe Qamiri, Toshi & Dorina.
